## About Us

Gloddaeth ("Glod") Holidays is an exciting Christian ministry sharing the good news of Jesus with thousands of young people each year through our residential camps and schools ministry. We run a programme of Easter and summer camps for young people aged 10–18, from schools across the North and Midlands with currently 250–300 attending each year. Alongside this, we work with schools throughout the year, supporting Christian meetings, assemblies and chapels.

Our camps are at the heart of what we do – fun, high-quality holidays where young people build friendships and explore the Christian faith, many for the first time. We also run an extensive leadership training programme geared towards our 150–200 volunteer leaders.

This is a significant time for the ministry. We are observing an increased spiritual interest in our school visits, with many young people asking big questions of meaning and purpose. 70–80% of the young people who attend our camps come from unchurched backgrounds. While our longstanding focus on independent schools continues, we are beginning to explore how we might also serve pupils in state schools.

## About You

We are looking for someone with a clear commitment to the gospel and prayer whose character is marked by grace, gentleness and humility. You'll require good pastoral skills and some experience of working with young people and ideally students. Your ability to teach is a priority, with experience of Bible handling

and teaching in a number of settings. You'll be someone who is flexible and happy to work within the rhythm of camps, schools work, and year-round events. You would enjoy both being part of a supportive team as well as spending time by yourself, along with taking initiative in your own areas of responsibility. Above all you will need a passion for Jesus and enjoy sharing him with others as you make a difference spiritually, under God, to the lives of young people and adult volunteer leaders.

This role might suit someone with experience of teaching, church-based youth work, or a ministry trainee programme. We welcome applications both from those with previous experience of our camps, or from those who haven't been involved before as we value the new insights, perspectives and opportunities that would bring.

## About the Role

This front-line ministry role has much variety including visiting schools to run Christian meetings and assemblies, as well as assisting with the residential weekends and holidays throughout the year. Working alongside an experienced female staff worker, the main focus is on equipping girls and women to hear of

Jesus, to grow in faith and to be cared for in their involvement with God both at camp and year-round. It involves a blend of supporting people to grow in faith along with helping the many young people who are still exploring what they believe for themselves. It also comprises developing new links into new schools so as many as possible can hear the gospel. There may be opportunities for further Biblical training if desirable.

## Key Responsibilities

### Schools Ministry

- Visit schools to support and run Christian meetings, chapels, and assemblies
- Build and develop relationships with schools and explore new opportunities
- Support teachers in schools

### Camps & Events

- Play a full part in the delivery of residential camps and year-round events
- Build relationships with young people on camp, supporting them pastorally and helping

them engage with the gospel

- Contribute to the teaching programme, including leading Bible studies and giving talks
- Help create a fun, welcoming and well-run camp environment

### Leaders & Discipleship

- Support the recruitment, training and care of volunteer leaders and undergraduate assistant leaders
- Contribute to training events and year-round development opportunities.

### Wider Ministry Involvement

- To pray for the work of God and those involved in it
- Share in some administrative tasks
- Set aside time for personal study
